Authorities

Special Constables are delegated police powers to enforce various laws anywhere in the City of Toronto if the offence they are investigating is on or in relation to Toronto Community Housing property or vehicles.

Special Constables

- Support community safety and well-being of tenants;
- Respond to calls for service that they receive by radio or in person, including medical and fire incidents;
- Investigate antisocial behaviour and criminal activity;
- Enforcement of Federal and Provincial Statutes;
- Take part in community meetings and activities.

Unit goals

- Promote safety in our communities;
- Protect Toronto Community Housing property;
- Partner with community stakeholders to promote community safety and well-being.

What happens when you call?

When you call **416-921-2323** the dispatcher will ask you questions to determine what type of help you need.

Dispatchers cannot:

- Handle calls not related to security;
- Transfer calls to other departments;
- Share personal information;
- Resolve parking infractions.

Dispatchers can:

- Take information you provide, determine if the situation is lifethreatening and alert the proper authorities;
- Send Special Constables to assist.

Callers may remain anonymous.

Who do you call?

In an emergency, always call 911.

- 911 connects you to Emergency Medical Services, Toronto Police Service and Toronto Fire Services.
- Service is provided in many languages.
